COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Brush will be collected curbside on your regularly scheduled trash & recycling collection day.

DIRECTIONS

- Bind brush with string or twine in lengths of 40 inches or less.
 - Smaller twigs & branches may be placed in metal or plastic trash cans which will be emptied & returned to the curb.
 - Brush that is over six inches in diameter will not be collected.
 - No leaves, garden waste, or grass clippings will be collected. Leaves can be brought to the Post Road Compost Facility.

NEW FOR 2023

Residents will rake leaves curbside to be collected by the leaf vacuum. Paper bags will NOT be collected.

COLLECTION SCHEDULE

The leaf vacuum will follow the trash & recycling collection schedule as closely as possible.

DIRECTIONS

- Residents should rake leaves into street no more than 24 hours in advance of scheduled collection.
- Leaves must be placed approx. one foot away from curb or edge of road pavement in a row parallel to the curb or edge. The row must not be higher than three feet or wider than four feet.
- Leaves must not be placed within five feet of any parked vehicle, storm drain, or any other obstacle. Leaves also cannot be placed within ramps of designated crosswalks.
- **ONLY** leaves should be raked to the curb. No sticks, twigs, branches, trash, or other debris.
