## ORDINANCE NO. 2432

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CARLISLE. CHAPTER 255, BY REDUCING MINIMUM PARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR DWELLINGS.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Carlisle, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 255-204 [Number of required spaces for dwellings], Paragraph A, of Article XXV [Off-Street Parking and Loading] of Chapter 255 [Zoning] of the Code of the Borough of Carlisle is hereby amended to provide in its entirety as follows:

A. Unless fewer minimum parking spaces are permitted by the applicable zoning district, the current parking minimum is one (1) off-street parking space per dwelling unit with one-bedroom or less and two (2) off-street parking spaces per dwelling unit with two or more bedrooms.

SECTION 2: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. If any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or any other provision, section, article or chapter of the Code of the Borough of Carlisle.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.
