COMMUNITY GARDEN APPLICATION

RECOMMENDED BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES TO CG ORDINANCE

In order to encourage high quality community gardens, good management techniques and to ensure a process to address residential concerns, the community garden manager and/or landowner shall create and have each garden participant sign sample guidelines which include at least the following tenets and no others which would be in conflict with the intent of these or any other provision in this ordinance.

Per current borough code, I will keep weeds at a minimum and maintain the areas immediately surrounding my plot, if any;

I will properly store all gardening tools;

I will keep trash and litter out of the plot, as well as from adjacent pathways and fences;

I will participate in a planned fall clean-up of the garden;

I will not create areas of standing water;

I will respect hours of use that adhere to existing Borough sound and light codes restrictions.

Responsible pesticide use will be used;

The Carlisle Borough Property Maintenance Code will be enforced on all aspects of the community garden.
