Consider the following information to determine if you can plant a tree(s):

- Tree stumps must be ground 18 inches below ground level before planting in the same spot.
- No tree can be planted nearer than 35 feet to an intersection or alley.
- Trees need to be planted 30 to 40 feet apart where practical.
- Where there is a sidewalk, cuts will be made 3 feet square at no cost to the property owner.
- Trees will not be less than 1 ¾ inches in caliper.
- Trees must be planted at least ten feet from utility poles, and at least six feet from water, sewer and gas services.
- Property owners must water and maintain the trees once they are planted. New trees should be watered weekly, especially during hot, dry weather.
- Trees will eventually require some pruning. Tree pruning and removal permits are required for any tree work done by the property owner or a tree surgeon. There is no fee for the permit.
