

Because of the increased number of door-to-door solicitors operating in the Borough of Carlisle this summer, the Carlisle Police Department wants to provide information to Borough residents on door-to-door solicitations.

Borough residents are advised that anyone soliciting door-to-door in the Borough of Carlisle must possess a Transient Vendor Permit and wear a yellow badge which shows “Carlisle Police Department Vendor Permit” with an assigned I.D. number. Also, door-to-door solicitation is only authorized Monday-Saturday from 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Any solicitor who is not wearing a badge has NOT been approved by the Carlisle Police Department to go door-to-door and is in violation of the Borough’s Transient Vendor Ordinance (Chapter 237).

In order to receive a Transient Vendor Permit, solicitors must go through a criminal history check, pay an application fee and wear the required badge.

Residents who are contacted by door-to-door solicitors who they suspect do not possess a permit to solicit in the Borough are asked to call the Carlisle Police immediately at 243-5252 and give the location of where the solicitation is taking place.

Political and religious solicitations are exempt from the Carlisle Borough Transient Vendor process.

A current listing of permitted Transient Vendors is as follows:
