HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW BOARD MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

Consent Agenda:

1. Approve the minutes of the July 31, 2017 meeting.

Consensus: On a motion by Bill White and second by Maureen Reed, HARB voted unanimously to recommend approval of the May 30th minutes.

Regular Agenda:

1. A request by Christopher Rice of the Martson Law Offices for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 10 East High Street. The applicant proposes to replace two signs, approximately 22.5" x 36" at each side of the front entrance with two signs of the same size, same location. Sign material is to be polycarbonate with silver nameplates identifying the firm's attorneys.

Consensus: On a motion by Bill White and second by Maureen Reed, HARB voted unanimously to recommend approval of the above request.

2. A request by Dickinson College for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 199 West High Street. The applicant proposes to replace the existing exterior vertical wheelchair lift at the rear (north side) of the building with a new lift of similar size and design.

Consensus: On a motion by Bill White and second by Deb Jussel, HARB voted unanimously to recommend approval of the above request.

Ms. Katie Hess, a resident of Arch Street, appeared before the Board to discuss issues that she had encountered with UGI's proposed gas meter re-location from the basement of her home to the exterior. Ms. Hess expressed her concern that her home's appearance will be adversely affected. Several Board members provided insight and advice resulting from their own experiences dealing with gas meter re-location on properties they own. Ms. Hess indicated that she was appreciative.

Having no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
