Consent Agenda:

Consent Agenda:

1. Approve the minutes of the May 2, 2016 meeting.
2. A request by CALC for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 38 West Pomfret Street. The applicant proposes to install a 20" by 50" wall sign above the entrance door that will state "CALC" in brown background with silver lettering. The entrance door sign will state "CALC GALLERY CLASSES FINE ARTS & CRAFTS".
3. A request by Michelle Stump for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 152 East Liberty Avenue. The applicant proposes to replace the metal, standing seam roof with a new metal, standing seam roof.

Regular Agenda:

1. A request by Eric & Kathleen Storms for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 133 South Hanover Street. The applicant proposes the following:
  - Remove dilapidated exterior stairs at rear on main structure. They are not original to the house.
  - Replace wood ceiling on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor rear porch with tongue and groove pine boards. The wood porch floor will be replaced with tongue and groove flooring.
  - The porch wood posts and rails will be replaced with similar style wood
  - The porch doors will be replaced with a 9 lite fiberglass and 4 panel fiberglass doors
  - The Chapel Avenue entrance door will be replaced with a 4 panel fiberglass door
  - All of the wood, double hung, 1/1 windows will be replaced with Marvin fiberglass windows. The two front, curved bow windows will be hand made by Coyle Lumber Company and have wood sashes with curved windows
2. A request by Alibi's for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 10 North Pitt Street. The applicant proposes the following:
  - Remove the current storefront on the east wall including windows, brick and trim boards

- Reconstruct the wall using 4' by 12' windows and a raised panel design below the windows
- Install four gooseneck down lights
