**Consent Agenda:**

*The following is a list of routine items that do not appear to be controversial and probably do not require additional discussion. These items can be acted on with one motion.*

1. Approve the minutes of the August 31, 2015 meeting.
2. A request by the Cumberland County Historical Society for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 29 West High Street. The applicant proposes to install a 26" by 30" wooden, projecting sign on the brick pilaster to the right of the front window eight feet off of the ground. The sign will state "The G. B. Stuart History Workshop" in white and blue lettering with blue and tan background. It will be attached to the building with a wrought iron bracket.
3. A request by Pixel & Hammer for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 52 East High Street. The applicant proposes to install a 2' by 3' wall sign on the front façade to the left of the entrance door. The sign will be constructed of sign form (resin) and be carved in a three dimensional, wooden look. The sign will state "Pixel & Hammer print web mobile" in white lettering with white and black background.

**Consensus:** Upon a motion by Bill White and second by John Lampi, the Board voted unanimously to recommend approval of the above requests.

**Regular Agenda:**

1. A request by Art & Mary Roell for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 54-58 East Louthier Street. The applicant proposes to replace the existing metal, standing seam roofs with the same profile, metal standing seam roofs.

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Mary Roell explained to the Board's satisfaction what she was doing.


**Consensus:** Upon a motion by Bill White and second by Maureen Reed, the Board voted unanimously to recommend approval of the above request.

4. A request by Fares Beainy for a Certificate of Appropriateness at 46 South Bedford Street. The applicant proposes to replace the one lite, two panel wooden entrance door with a four panel wood door.
