South St., Carlisle, PA, at which time testimony will also be taken and a hearing held on the following application(s), and to consider such other business as might come before it:

No. 19-01. A request by Natacha Seraphin, for a Special Exception at 121 E. Louther Street. The property is zoned R-4 Town Center Residential, and the applicant seeks relief pursuant to Section 255-234.E.4, which requires Zoning Hearing Board approval for a change in use from an existing non-conforming use to another non-conforming use. The building formerly contained a sales & service shop for home electronics, which was approved by the ZHB in 2014. The applicant proposes the retail sale of beauty supplies and ethnic food products and the operation of a beauty salon.
