MEMBER BENEFITS

Take advantage of our Pool Member benefits including quick entry to the pool, free lounge chair rentals, discounted daily guest rate (limit one guest per member per day), discounted pool rental rates, members only end of season party, and early registration for swim lessons (March 27—April 28).

GENERAL POOL RULES

1. **Season Pass Holders** must scan their card when entering the pool each day (just once per day). If you forget your membership card more than 3 times you will need to pay \$5 for a replacement card or pay the admission fee.
2. Pennsylvania law requires all swimmers should take a soap shower and rinse thoroughly BEFORE entering the pool.
3. Persons that are not toilet trained are required to wear waterproof swimwear / swim diapers that fit snugly around the legs and waist. Swim diapers are available for \$2 at the front desk.
4. *Children 12 years of age and younger MUST be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years of age or older who will accept the responsibility for the safety and conduct of the child – NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. Adult Swims: only children under age 5 are permitted to be in the pool with an adult over the age of 18.
6. Any flotation aid (swimmies, inner tubes, kickboards, noodles, etc.) must be kept in water less than 5 feet deep, and may be prohibited if the pool is crowded.
7. Soft type balls and other pool toys are permitted when the pool is not crowded.
8. Any music should be listened to with headsets.
9. **Daily Admission:**
 - a) Patrons must show photo identification upon entrance to the facility.
 - b) Non-swimmers/chaperones who wish to enter the pool must pay the admission fee.
 - c) Daily admission patrons must get stamped at the front desk upon leaving the pool, or pay the admission fee to get back in.
10. The Carlisle Community Pool is not responsible for any valuables or personal property brought into the facility. Lockers are not available.
11. **Please do not talk to or distract the lifeguards on the stand unless it's an emergency.**
12. *Disobeying and disrespecting pool staff WILL NOT be tolerated. Uncooperative patrons will be asked to leave.
13. *NO running on the concrete or near the pool water; pushing, rough housing, fighting or lewd behavior.
14. *NO profane, crude or obscene language regardless of age.
15. *Prohibited: smoking/tobacco/e-cigarettes, alcohol/drugs, weapons, glass containers, animals, and large coolers. You may smoke in your vehicle or on the sidewalk.

* = **ZERO TOLERANCE: may result in immediate ejection from the facility.**

DIVING WELL & LANE LINES

1. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time; and only one bounce is permitted.
2. Diving is only permitted in the diving well. Weight capacity for the diving board is 250 lbs.
3. Patrons may NOT enter the water backwards or dive to the side.
4. No flotation devices in the diving well. All flotation devices must be kept in water less than 5 feet deep.
5. After diving please exit diving area immediately.
6. Lane lines are for lap swimmers only.
7. Proper lap swimming etiquette is required. Please do not hang on the lane lines.

8. You must be able to swim the entire length of the pool to swim laps in the lane lines.

AQUA CLIMB WALL

1. Non-swimmers are prohibited.
2. Only one climber at a time. One attempt per climber. Once you fall, head to the back of the line.
3. No flips or twists of any kind. Feet-first entry only.
4. No swimming in the "Drop Zone".
5. No hanging from the glass board at the top.
6. For your own safety patrons must use the hand grips to climb, not the sides of the wall.

WADING POOL

1. Children in the wading pool must be 8 years of age or under.
2. Children must be supervised by a responsible person 16 years of age or older.
3. The lifeguard at the wading pool is responsible for the safety of *all* children and patrons in the area; therefore, the parent or guardian's supervision of their child or children is critical.

WATER SLIDE

1. A staff member at the top of the slide will indicate when it is safe to go down the slide.
2. Sliders must be at least 54" tall.
3. No chains, jewelry, buttons, watches, swimmies, lifejackets, and/or goggles when using the slide.
4. One slider at a time – no stopping.
5. Patrons must slide and enter the pool feet first.
6. Patrons are NOT permitted to wait in the landing area for a slider.

PATRON DISCIPLINE POLICY

Violations of the Carlisle Community Pool rules and policies will result in corrective actions. Violators may be suspended, expelled, or banned (without refund) from the pool complex for a length of time to be determined by staff.

CLOSING POLICY

During the season, the pool may close if one or more of the following occurs:

- Inclement weather
- Unforeseen emergency/maintenance
- Thunder and/or lightning. Swimmers will be required to remain clear of the pool for 30 minutes after the last incident of lightning or thunder.
