

### Drug Activity

The Carlisle Police Department in partnership with the Cumberland County Drug Task Force investigates drug activity in the Borough.

#### What you should do:

Call the Carlisle Police Department (717) 243-5252 Option 3, to report the following activities.

### Underage/Public Drinking

The consumption of alcoholic beverages on a sidewalk or street corner is prohibited by law.

It is illegal to sell or provide alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

### Loitering

Carlisle Police Department can issue citations for loitering if there is drug activity involved.

Borough ordinance requires that persons under 16 years of age must be in their homes by 10pm. Persons 16-18 years of age must be in their homes by 11pm.

### Excessive Noise

Borough ordinance regulates the level of noise for:

- Music played indoors, outdoors or on car stereos
- The operation of vehicles including loud starts or stops
- Arguments and shouting

### Animal Neglect

Owners of pets can be cited for animal neglect if they deny their animal food, water or shelter.

### Codes Department

Contact the Carlisle Borough Codes Department (717) 240-6930 to report any of the following:

### High Grass or Trash

Weeds and grass in yards, sidewalks or tree wells may not be higher than six (6) inches.



Property owners are responsible for the removal of trash from their property and sidewalk in front of their home.

### Other Issues

If you suspect any of the following, contact the Carlisle Police Department at (717) 243-5252:

- Suspected child abuse
- Domestic Violence
- Gambling or prostitution
