

**ORDINANCE NO. 2239**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CARLISLE WITH RESPECT TO CHAPTER 244, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, TO EXTEND THE TIME TO PAY CERTAIN PARKING VIOLATIONS AND AMEND THE FINE AND METHODS OF PAYMENT OF CERTAIN PARKING VIOLATIONS.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Carlisle, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Paragraph B of Section 244-30 [Penalties For Parking Violations] of Article IV [Street Parking Metered Zones] of Chapter 244 [Vehicles and Traffic] of the Code of the Borough of Carlisle is hereby amended in its entirety to provide as follows:

B. The law enforcement officer making such report shall also attach to every such vehicle a notice that such vehicle was parked in violation of this article, which notice shall contain instructions to the owner or driver of such vehicle that, if he or she shall pay, for the use of the Borough, the sum of \$15 within ten (10) days after the time of such notice, or the sum of \$20 if paid after ten (10) days, the same shall save the violator from prosecution and from the additional payment of the costs of prosecution. Payment shall be made by US mail to the office of the Finance Director, in person at the Borough Hall, at the drop box at either the Borough Hall or the Police Department or by online internet payment. The owner or driver shall be liable for the necessary postage if he or she mails such amount.

SECTION 2: Paragraph B of Section 244-37 [Duty of police officers] of Article IV [Street Parking Metered Zones] of Chapter 244 [Vehicles and Traffic] of the Code of the Borough of Carlisle is hereby amended in its entirety to provide as follows:

B. Every police officer shall also place upon such vehicle a notice that such vehicle was parked in violation of this article, which notice shall

contain instructions to the owner or driver of such vehicle that, if he or she shall pay, for the use of the Borough, the sum of \$15 within ten (10) days after the time of such notice, or the sum of \$20 if paid after ten (10) days, the same shall save the violator from prosecution and from the additional payment of the costs of prosecution. Payment shall be made by US mail to the office of the Finance Director, in person at the Borough Hall, at the drop box at either the Borough Hall or the Police Department or by online internet payment. The owner or driver shall be liable for the necessary postage if he or she mails such amount. Provided, however, that for each additional notice of violation by the same vehicle within the same parking space in the same twenty-four-hour period, the required payment within ten (10) days after the time of such notice shall be the sum of \$10 to save such violator from prosecution.

SECTION 3: Paragraph B of Section 244-58 [Duty of police officers] of Article VI [Off-Street Fee Parking] of Chapter 244 [Vehicles and Traffic] of the Code of the Borough of Carlisle is hereby amended in its entirety to provide as follows:

B. Every police officer shall also place upon such vehicle a notice that such vehicle was parked in violation of this article, which notice shall contain instructions to the owner or driver of such vehicle that, if he or she shall pay, for the use of the Borough, the sum of \$15 within ten (10) days after the time of such notice, or the sum of \$20 if paid after ten (10) days, the same shall save the violator from prosecution and from the additional payment of the costs of prosecution. Payment shall be made by US mail to the office of the Finance Director, in person at the Borough Hall, at the drop box at either the Borough Hall or the Police Department or by online internet payment. The owner or driver shall be liable for the necessary postage if he or she mails such amount. Provided, however, that for each additional notice of violation by the same vehicle within the same parking space in the same twenty-four-hour period, the required payment within

ten (10) days after the time of such notice shall be the sum of \$10 to save such violator from prosecution.

SECTION 4: In all other respects, Chapter 244 [Vehicles and Traffic] of the Code of the Borough of Carlisle shall remain as heretofore enacted, ordained and amended, which said Chapter, as amended, is hereby re-enacted in its entirety herein.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall become effective in accordance with applicable law.
