MEMBER BENEFITS

Take advantage of our Pool Member benefits including quicker entry to the pool, free lounge chair rentals (*limited supply*), discounted daily guest rate (*limit one guest per member per day*), discounted pool rental rates, and members only private pool party.

MEMBER INFORMATION

1. CCP Members stop at the front desk to scan their card when entering the pool each day (just once per day).
2. If your season pass is forgotten more than 3 times you will need to pay \$5 for a replacement card.
3. Members are limited to one guest per present member per day at the discounted daily admission rate \$5/person.
4. \$20.00 fee applies when changing your membership after the initial membership is purchased.
5. Membership Discounts: \$15 off in January-February, \$10 off in March-April, \$5 off in May.
6. Family Pass = persons residing in the same household including no more than two adults. Children = 4-21 years. Proof of residency is required.
7. Add-On = a person who lives outside of the household such as a grandparent, nanny, babysitter, etc.

GENERAL POOL RULES

1. ***Children 12 years of age and younger MUST be accompanied by a responsible person 18 years of age or older who will accept the responsibility for the safety and conduct of the child – NO EXCEPTIONS.**
2. Pennsylvania law requires all swimmers should take a soap shower and rinse thoroughly BEFORE entering the pool.
3. *Persons that are not toilet trained are required to wear waterproof swimwear / swim diapers that fit snugly around the legs and waist. Swim diapers are available for \$2 at the front desk.
4. Daily Admission:
 - a) Patrons must show photo identification upon entrance to the facility.
 - b) Non-swimmers/chaperones who wish to enter the pool must pay the admission fee.
 - c) Daily admission patrons must get stamped at the front desk upon leaving the pool, or pay the admission fee to get back in.
5. 15 Minute Adult Swims: the purpose is to conduct a safety check. Only children under age 5 are permitted to be in the pool with an adult over the age of 18.
6. Any flotation aid (swimmies, inner tubes, kickboards, noodles, etc.) must be kept in water less than 5 feet deep, and may be prohibited if the pool is crowded.

7. Soft type balls and other pool toys are permitted when the pool is not crowded at the staff's discretion.
8. Personal music should be listened to with headphones.
9. The Carlisle Community Pool is not responsible for any valuables or personal property brought into the facility. Lockers are not available.
10. First Aid is available at the front desk.
11. Please do not talk to or distract the lifeguards on the stand unless it is an emergency.
12. For your safety we ask that you do not run on concrete or near the pool water.
13. *NO pushing, "chicken", dunking, rough housing, or fighting.
14. *NO profane, crude, obscene language or lewd behavior regardless of age.
15. *Prohibited: smoking/tobacco/e-cigarettes, alcohol/drugs, weapons, glass containers, and animals. You may smoke in your vehicle or on the sidewalk.
16. *Disobeying and disrespecting pool staff WILL NOT be tolerated. Uncooperative patrons will be asked to leave.

*** = ZERO TOLERANCE: may result in ejection from the facility.**

DIVING BOARD

1. Non-swimmers, and floatation devices are prohibited.
2. No swimming in the diving well. Only one person permitted on the diving board at a time.
3. The weight capacity for the diving board is 250 lbs.
4. Patrons may NOT enter the water backwards or sideways. Only one bounce is permitted.
5. After diving please exit diving area immediately.

LANE LINES

1. Non-swimmers, and floatation devices are prohibited.
2. You must be able to swim the entire length of the pool to swim laps in the lane lines.
3. Proper lap swimming etiquette is required. When there are more than two people in a lane, circle swimming is required. Stay to the right side of the lane. Stop only at the wall, do not wade in the lane lines. Do not swim under lane lines or hang on the lane lines.

AQUA CLIMB WALL

1. Non-swimmers are prohibited. Only one climber at a time in the drop zone.
2. One attempt per climber. Once you fall, exit the area and head to the back of the line.
3. No flips or twists of any kind. Feet-first entry only.
4. No swimming in the roped off "Drop Zone" below the wall.
5. No hanging from the glass board at the top.
6. For your own safety patrons must use the hand grips to climb, not the sides of the wall.

WADING POOL

1. Children in the wading pool must be 8 years of age or under.
2. Children must be supervised by a responsible person 16 years of age or older.
3. The lifeguard at the wading pool is responsible for the safety of *all* children and patrons in the area; therefore, the parent or guardian's supervision of their child or children is critical.

WATER SLIDE

1. Non-swimmers are prohibited.
2. One person on the water slide at a time – no stopping.
3. Pool staff stationed at the top of the slide, will indicate when it is safe to go down the slide.

4. No chains, jewelry, buttons, swimmies, lifejackets, and/or goggles when using the slide.
5. Patrons must slide and enter the pool feet first.
6. With permission from pool staff, patrons may be permitted to wait at the back of the landing area for a slider.
7. Please exit the landing area immediately.

PATRON DISCIPLINE POLICY

Violations of the Carlisle Community Pool rules and policies will result in corrective actions. Violators may be suspended, expelled, or banned (without refund) from the pool complex for a length of time to be determined by management.

CLOSING POLICY

During the season, the pool may close if one or more of the following occurs:

- Inclement weather.
- Unforeseen emergency/maintenance/staffing issues.
- Thunder and/or lightning. Swimmers will be required to remain clear of the pool and sidewalks for 30 minutes after the last incident of lightning or thunder.

- Rain checks may be issued when the facility must be closed due to storm or emergency. They will only be issued to those admitted within 30 minutes of the closure.

These rules were created to ensure the health and safety for all patrons at the Carlisle Community Pool. While we wish that you have an enjoyable experience, for safety and security reasons we must enforce the rules. Thank you for your cooperation!

RENTAL INFORMATION

___Private Pool Party: Reserve the entire pool including the pavilion for your own private birthday party, family reunion, work party, or bar mitzvah! Outside food/beverage is permitted. The concession stand is not available during a private pool party. *Pool Members receive a \$25 discount on the hourly rate.

Available: Fridays or Saturdays: 6:30 – 8:30PM
Fee: \$200 per hour (*without Tot Pool*)
Extra: Tot Pool = \$25/hour

___Public Pool Party: Package includes either **2 or 4** hours of swimming during public hours and pavilion reservation. Additional fees will apply if your party stays longer than your reservation. Outside food/beverage is permitted at the pavilion area only. *Pool Members receive a \$25 discount on the party package.

Available: Sunday – Thursday: 1:00 – 3:00PM, 3:00 – 5:00PM, &/or 5:00 – 7:00PM
Friday – Saturday: 12:00 – 2:00PM, 2:00 – 4:00PM &/or 4:00 – 6:00PM
2 Hour Package: 1-25 participants = \$125
26+ participants = \$125 plus additional \$4 per person
4 Hour Package: 1-25 participants = \$175
26+ participants = \$175 plus additional \$4 per person

_____Pavilion Rental: Reserve the entire pavilion (8 tables) during normal pool hours for a maximum of two hours. Additional fees apply for daily admission. Outside food/beverage is permitted at the pavilion area only.

Available: Sunday – Thursday: 1:00 – 3:00PM, 3:00 – 5:00PM, &/or 5:00 – 7:00PM
Friday – Saturday: 12:00 – 2:00PM, 2:00 – 4:00PM &/or 4:00 – 6:00PM
Fee: \$40/day (8 tables)
\$FREE for Pool Members

RENTAL POLICY

1. Your party is responsible for all set up, and clean up. Supplies for cleanup will be provided upon request. Make sure to include set-up and clean-up time in your reservation. *For example: if your rental is from 3:00pm to 5:00pm your party should be cleaned up and ready to go by 5:00pm, not just starting to clean up at 5:00pm. There may be other reservations after yours.*
2. Everyone in the party must enter through the front doors of the bathhouse. You may request to have the pavilion gate opened if there are large items to set up, such as a grill, or large coolers.
3. **Public Pool Party:**
 - An additional \$4.00 per person will be due at the Carlisle Community Pool, 1236 Franklin Street Carlisle PA 17013, on the day of the event for over 25 people. *For example, if there are 30 people in attendance the amount due the day of would be an additional \$20.00.* Every person in attendance will count, even non-swimmers.
 - Daily admission fees do apply if participants in your party stay longer than your reservation.
 - Outside food/beverage IS permitted in the pavilion area only.
4. **Private Pool Party:**
 - Outside food/beverage IS permitted in the concession or pavilion area only.
5. All pool rules and regulations apply unless otherwise stated in this policy.

Payments:

1. Payment and rental application due at the time the reservation is placed.
2. Make check payable to the Carlisle Community Pool.

Cancellations:

1. Should the pool close early due to inclement weather, pool staff will contact you 2 hours prior to your event to inform you of the closure. You will have the option to reschedule or receive a full refund.
2. If you arrive at the pool for your reservation and it closes due to inclement weather, and you have utilized less than half of your contracted time, you may receive half of your payment in a refund.
3. Should your party arrive at the pool and you elect to leave early, we will retain all fees that have been received.
4. Should you call and cancel at least 2 hours before your event due to legitimate weather concerns, you may reschedule or receive a full refund.
5. Should you call and cancel at any time prior to the rental date, you will be charged a \$25.00 cancellation fee.
6. "No shows" will not receive any refund.
